



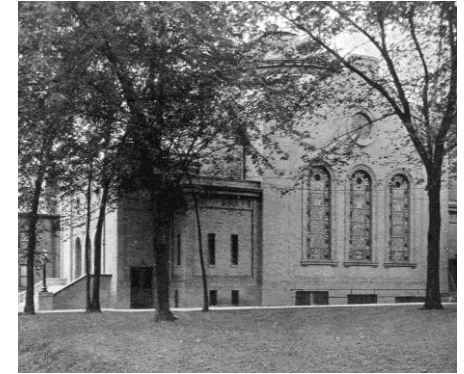
Much has changed since 1924...

- Make our Temple accessible to everyone regardless of physical ability, both in our seating and our access to the Torah
- Replace flooring and seating

- Upgrade our elevator so we can focus all of our praying in the sanctuary!
- Provide an additional handicap accessible rest room in place of one of our cloakrooms
- Update our lighting
- Restore our beautiful dome
- Keep the sloped floor while providing access to our Torah for everyone
- Rewire our memorial boards so they can again be lit at Yizkor services
- Accomplish this modest renewal effort without unnecessary expense



This has been home to Temple Israel for close to a century. Most of us have never seen this view of our building that dates from those early years. We have an excellent opportunity to renovate as we continue to celebrate here, bring future generations onto our Bima and welcome new families into our congregation.
